# Prep Curriculum Overview - Term 1 2025

### <u>English</u>

This term, students are working on sharing their thoughts and preferences about imaginative stories. They will practice expressing their ideas clearly and confidently, using their voice to communicate the events of a story to their friends. Students will also focus on using specific words and phrases from the story to explain their ideas and make their retelling more engaging. This will help them improve both their speaking and comprehension skills.

## **Maths**

In this unit, students will:

- Make connections between number names, numerals and position in the sequence of numbers from zero to 10
- Make and partition collections up to 5
- Answer yes or no questions to collect and record data
- Create and interpret picture graphs
- Describe the position and location of ourselves and objects

### **Science**

In this unit, students will explore their senses and how scientists use these to learn about the world. Students will investigate these senses through a range of hands on experiences.

### <u>HaSS</u>

In this unit, students will identify significant people and event in their own lives, and how significant events are celebrated or commemorated. They will discuss and share personal observations and perspectives on their personal histories and special places that contribute to their sense of identity, connection and belonging.

### <u>Health</u>

This semester, students will describe similarities and differences between themselves and others, and different emotions people experience. They will also practise personal and social skills to interact respectfully with others through imaginative text and when participating in physical activities.

### **Physical Education**

In this unit, students demonstrate fundamental movement skills (instep pass, punt kick and one hand strike) and test alternatives to solve AFL movement challenges (to reach their targets). All Prep to Year 6 classes will be preparing for Cross Country during the later part of Term 1. The Cross Country is on Wednesday 26th March. More information to come.

### The Arts

In The Arts this year, students will explore music, dance, drama, media and visual art. They will create artwork using different materials and technology and express themselves through movement. Throughout the year, students will both make and respond to various art forms, reflecting on their work and the work of others. This will help them develop critical thinking, creativity, and an appreciation for the arts in all its forms.
