This funding will be used to

- Increase the proportion of students receiving an A & B in Years P-10 English to 40%.
- Maintain 100% attainment of a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) or a Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement (QCIA)
- Increase the percentage of students at or above NAPLAN national minimum standards in Reading
- Over 40% of student in Year 3 in the upper two bands for NAPLAN Reading.
- Over 30% of students in Year 5 in the upper two bands for NAPLAN Reading.
- Over 20% of students in Years 7 in the upper two bands for NAPLAN Reading.
- Over 15% of students in Years 9 in the upper two bands for NAPLAN Reading.
- Implement the BYOD program in the Secondary school with more than 200 students participating in the program in 2018.
- Employ a transition officer to assist year 12s successfully transition to post school education, training or workforce options

- Enhance and track Student Attendance throughout the College
- Enhance vertical and horizontal alignment of curriculum through Year Level Coordinators, and Success Coaches.
- Enhance the leadership capacity of the College by providing quality PD focused on leadership.
- Implementing the explicit teaching framework and providing all staff with quality PD to support this implementation.
- Enhance the STEM resources in the College to make this a school of excellence in science and technology.
- Purchase resources to support a state of the art BYOD program in the Secondary School.
- Employee teacher aides from prep to Year 10 to support the reading agenda in the College.
- Fully implement Classroom Profiling across the College.
